Final prices include domestic media mail shipping costs of \$3 for the first item and \$1 for each additional title. Shipping costs for large orders are billed at actual cost. We honor purchase orders from institutional libraries, but request advance payment from other buyers. Drop ship orders from booksellers are honored.

Descriptions are based on standard terms used widely in the book trade:

- Mint:** As new (generally in original cellophane wrapping)
- Fine:** No defect in book or dustjacket, but not as crisp as a new book
- Very good:** Very light wear with no large tears or major defects
- Good:** Average used condition with some defects, as described.
- Fair:** A "reading copy" with major defects; we offer these free for postage costs.

"Wrappers" = paper covers. If this term is not included, the book is hardbound.

"dj" = dustjacket (or "dustwrapper").

"ex-lib" = library copy with the usual marks

The dissertations and theses are mostly photocopies that were part of the former Raptor Information System collection. Most have minor library marks and/or catalog numbers on the first page.

All titles are in very good-fine condition unless noted otherwise. More detailed information on condition can be supplied upon request. Publications may be returned for any reason in the original carton for a full refund of the purchase price plus media mail shipping costs.
