Bibliotheca Accipitraria II is the first comprehensive updating of James Edmund Harting's catalog since 1891. That work originally included works in twenty languages with eighty-seven in English and made it indispensable for falconers and book collectors over the last 120 years.

Bibliotheca Accipitraria II has expanded to 615 individual citations of works published in English from 1486 to 2000 along with references to hundreds of their reprints.

Bibliotheca Accipitraria II will continue the same exacting printing and binding standards of the three previous Heritage publications.

This edition will be slightly larger in height with wider internal margins to allow for bibliographic notes.

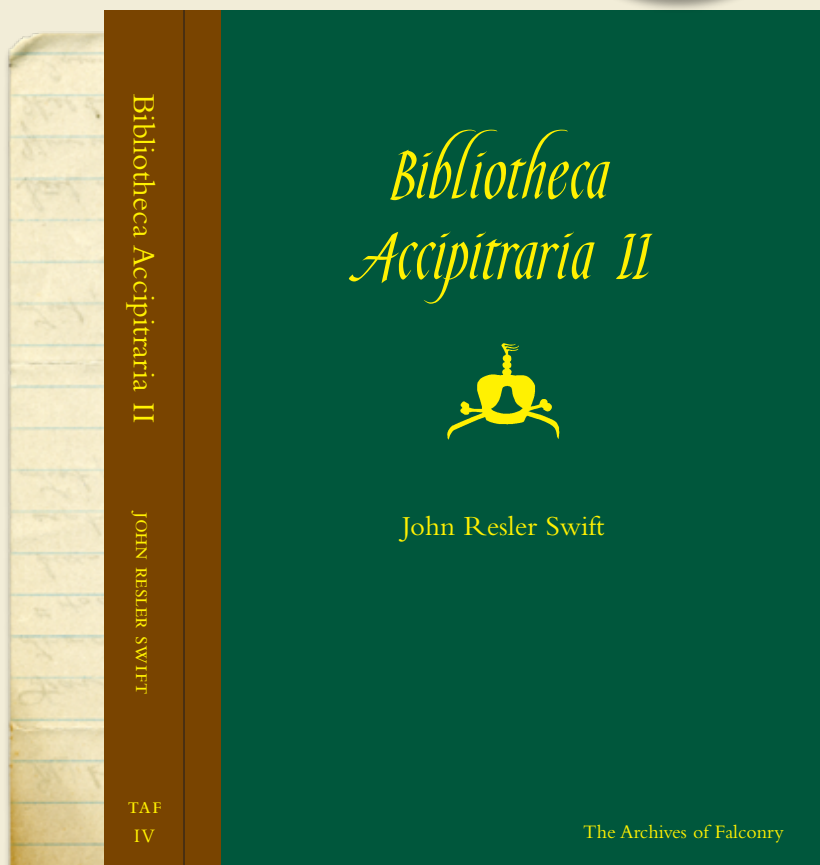
