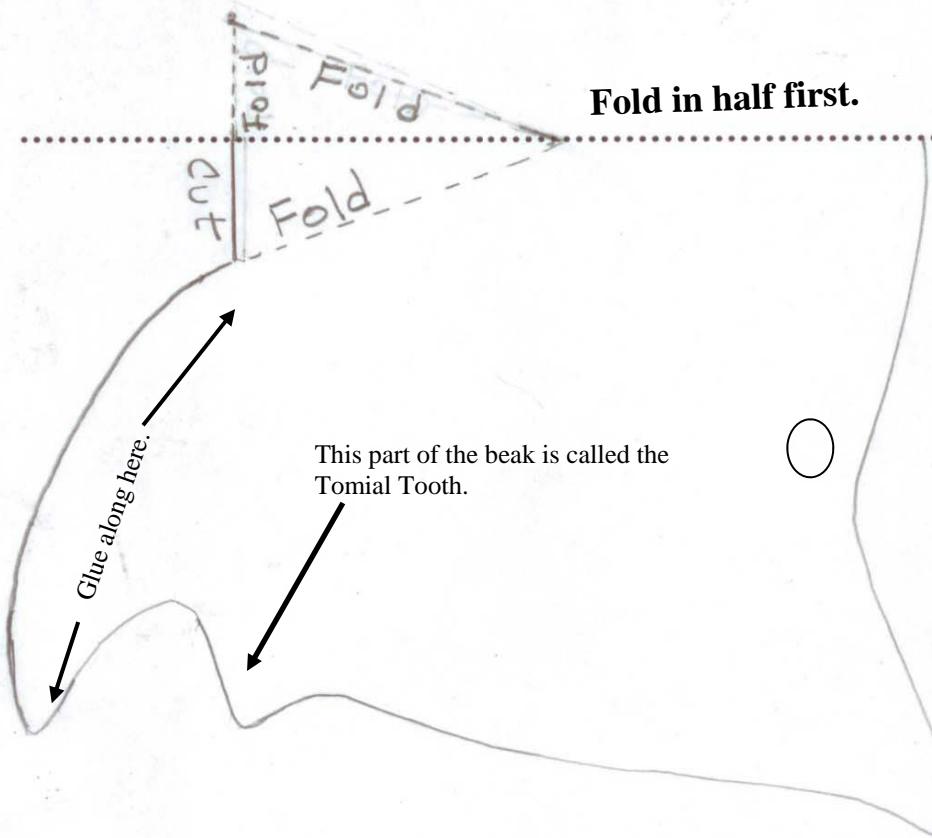


Falcon Beak

(Can you find the Tomial Tooth?)

1. Fold in half first (sandwich-fold with writing on **outside**).
- HINT: go over the dotted fold lines with a pencil to make folding easier!
2. Use a hole punch to punch a hole in both halves (thru the **circle**).
 3. Cut along the solid line next.
 4. Fold the triangle back & forth 3 times
 5. Reverse the sandwich-fold in half making the triangle go down inside the beak (writing on **inside**).
 6. Use a glue stick to glue the tips of the beak together.
 7. Attach enough string to the punched holes to wear the beak.

Fold in half first.

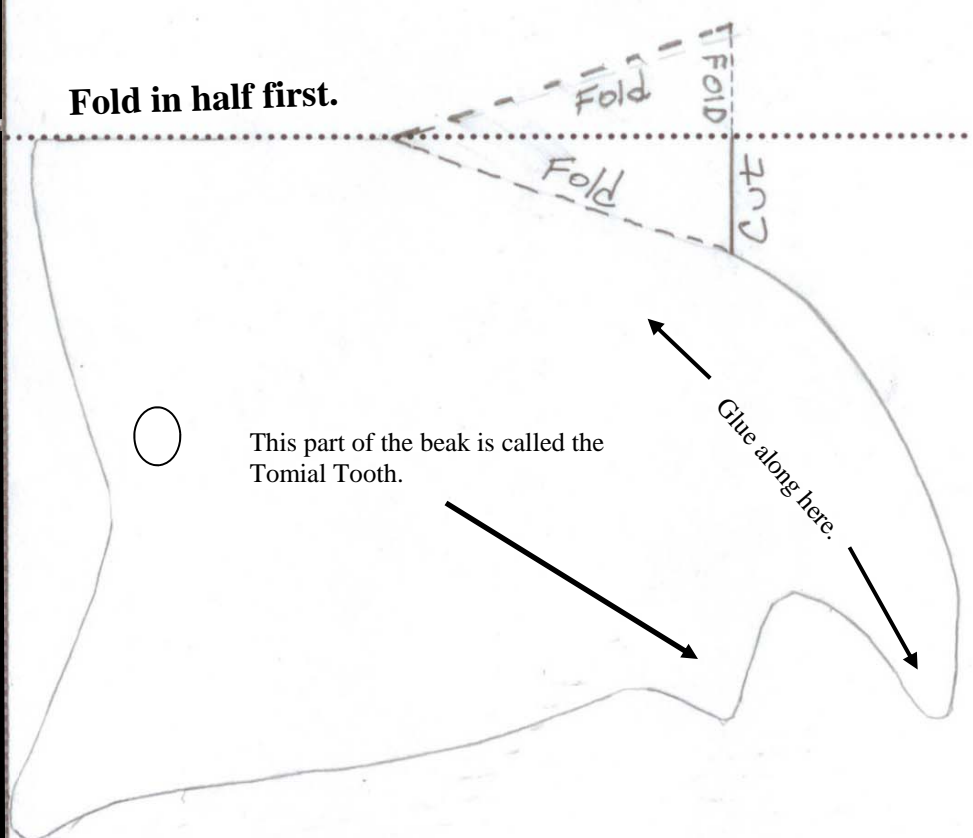


Falcon Beak

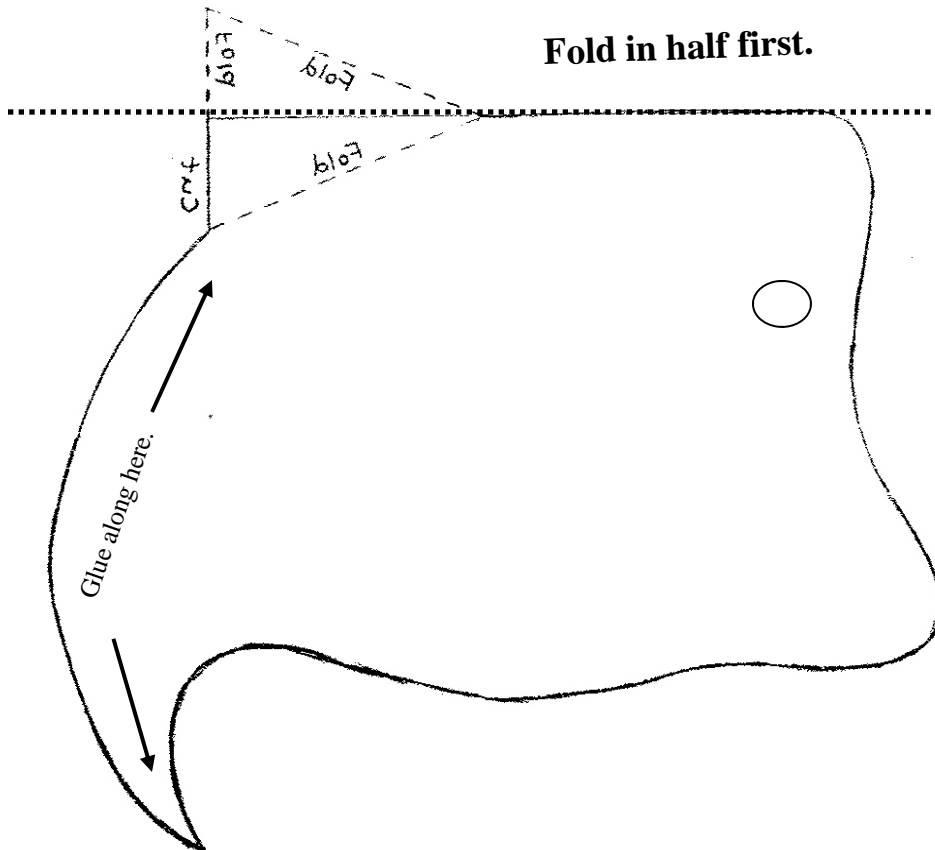
