

Money was born on
December 9, 1951 in Cody,
Wyoming to Gailand and
Leona Money. They moved
to Buffalo in 1960. Rande
graduated from Buffalo
High School in 1970. After
high school he attended the
University of Wyoming,
where he met the love of
his life, Kathryn Gibbs.
In 1971 he enlisted in the
United States Air Force.

He was stationed at Myrtle Beach, followed by Warren Air Force Base. Rande was honorably discharged in 1973. Kathryn and he were married on July 21, 1973, in Gillette, Wyoming, and made their home in Buffalo. After they were married Rande served with the National Guard. Their first daughter Heather was born in 1974, followed by their second daughter Paige in 1976.
